Note from the Pastor

In the way of your testimonies I delight as much as in all riches. I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways. I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word. -Psalm 119:14-16

Dear Chapin Presbyterian Church,

From time to time I have the opportunity to give counsel to people who are facing significant trials. Trouble in marriage, trouble in parenting, trouble at work or grief due to a lost loved one. The pressure of trials can stress us and depress us and make joy and hope seem like long lost tales of childhood. The realities of life can be challenging, frustrating, and unforgiving. Every time these opportunities arise I will walk with the person I am counseling back to the Gospel. I encourage them to remember:

- While you were still a sinner, Christ died for you.
- By your faith in Christ's accomplished work, your sins are forgiven.
- You are justified before God and adopted into His family.
- His Spirit dwells within you as a deposit guaranteeing your future inheritance.
- He has plans for your Kingdom work that are unique to you.

The enemy of our souls loves to drag us away from the Gospel on a daily basis. Even though the One who is in us is greater than the one who is in the world (I John 4:4), the enemy still distracts, and confuses, and distorts.

In these counseling sessions, I want to get back to the Gospel quickly. Next, I want to remind the Christian in front of me that their closest relationships are also under attack. Their marriages need special attention. Their parenting needs to be founded on love and pursued with Kingdom goals in mind, rather than behavior modification because they share your last name. Sometimes this relationship unpacking can take quite some time. Satan is the father of lies and he revels in disunity.

So here it is, I'm treating this article for our newsletter as one general counseling session. What I am seeing creep in amongst our particular church, as well as amongst the broader Church in America is the work of the enemy through the sickness, and fear, and frustration of COVID-19. Sickness and disunity and death are consequences of the Fall (Genesis 3). The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I (Christ) came that they may have life and have it abundantly (John 10:10). Dear brothers and sisters of CPC, commit with me to go back to the Gospel every day. This virus is among us, the fog is not lifting as quickly as we would like. We need to go back to the Gospel in God's Word regularly. Let God through the Gospel and through His Word light the way before us. Remember David said, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (Psalm 119:105). Notice here, David doesn't say my education, or my vocation, or MSNBC, or Fox News, or NPR, or the NY Times, are a lamp for me in this foggy and ambiguous time. He says God's Word is what leads him. Friends, we need a regular intake of God's Word. We need to be more familiar with the people of faith recorded in Scripture than we are with the talking heads on our particular news station of choice. Never in my lifetime has it been more clear to me that God is calling His people back to His Word than in the midst of this virus.

Consider this one big counseling take away that we all need to apply - open your Bible! Can we say with David that we delight in God's statutes and we will not forget His Word? Scripture will illumine truth to us and expose the lies and the plans of the enemy. We need our talking points to come from God's inspired, infallible, and inerrant Word and from NO PLACE ELSE. These are challenging times. I can feel the pressures of this virus season pressing in. Let's go back to God's Gospel and His Word together, regularly. May He continue to mold and shape us by His Word for His glory!

their lives on their own. Here's what research says is important to do at home NOW to help solidify your children's faith-little **things that may make a BIG DIFFERENCE**:

• Eat dinner together at least 5 times a week

• Serve with your family in a faith based ministry (here at CPC, We Care, mission trips, nursing homes, etc.)

• Serve at church on their own (usher, children's ministry helper, door greeter,...)

 Have at least one spiritual experience at home with the family each week (devotions from The Big Book of Questions and Answers about Jesus, read and talk about Scripture, talk about how God has worked around them and/or in their lives this week)

Being mentored by an adult other than a parent who has a strong faith

Most importantly, **pray for our Holy Spirit** to fill your home and hearts with His wisdom and guiding as you train up your children to know and trust God!
