Dear Saints.

Chapin Presbyterian Church exists to magnify Christ in hearts, homes, and the world. With worship as the engine of everything that we do, we want to major on the corporate gathering together of God's people to (as the reformed theologians stress) "attend to the means of grace." Means of Grace the means by which God dispenses grace to His people. Generally speaking, in corporate worship there are three means - the Word, the Sacraments, and Prayer. This does not include every means by which God dispenses grace to his people, but we believe these are the ordinary channels God has designed for this

purpose. Affirming these truths, we want to encourage you to continue to pursue in-person corporate worship. We stand on the truth of God's word, not on the statistical analysis provided by your major news stations. I look forward to seeing you on the Lord's Day.

The preschool version is "God keeps His promises."


