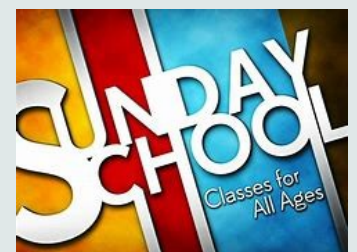

Dear Saints,

Chapin Presbyterian Church exists to magnify Christ in hearts, homes, and the world. With **worship** as the engine of everything that we do, we want to major on the corporate gathering together of God's people to (as the reformed theologians stress) "attend to the means of grace." Means of Grace - the means by which God dispenses grace to His people. Generally speaking, in corporate worship there are three means - the Word, the Sacraments, and Prayer. This does not include every means by which God dispenses grace to his people, but we believe these are the ordinary channels God has designed for this

purpose. Affirming these truths, we want to encourage you to continue to pursue in-person corporate worship. As we come to honor God with heart, soul, mind, and strength, His Spirit supernaturally over-reciprocates our offerings. We end up leaving with more to be thankful for than when the service began.

In short, worship is paramount to the Christian Life. You need it. I need it. We need it. Let these times, two years into Covid-19 and her variants, find us making wise decisions

We stand on the truth of God's word, not on the statistical analysis provided by your major news stations. I look forward to seeing you on the Lord's Day.

## **ALL IN THE FAMILY**



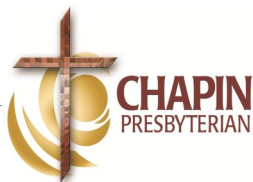
