Dear Saints,

I want to give you a brief thought about how good our Lord is as we approach resurrection Sunday. The Scripture says, *Christ came at the appointed time* (Rom 5:6, Gal 4:4). God's plan from the beginning was to give his Son for you and for me.


### Coming this month for HISKidZ:




## **UPCOMING REFORMED EVENTS & ACTIVITIES**
