Next **Sunday, July 10**, there will be a Congregational Meeting to include financial updates. Please make plans to attend this meeting following Worship Service.

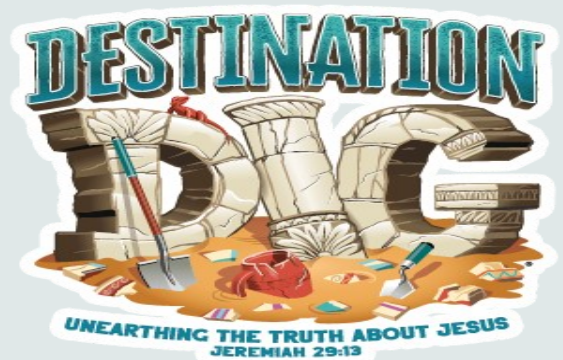
COMMUNION SUNDAY JULY 3, 2022
